


**STARs SUMMER SCHOOL**  
*Skills Transfers in Academia: a Renewed Strategy Enhancing Legal Clinics in the European Union*

The University of Brescia, Department of Law, will host the first summer school organized within the European Project STARs - Skills Transfers in Academia: a Renewed Strategy Enhancing Legal Clinics in the European Union, from Monday, July 2<sup>nd</sup> to Friday July 6<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

During the first summer school the Brescia Law Clinic will offer a structured replica of its traditional clinical activities, holding special clinical sessions and reproducing the methods and the pedagogical approaches applied in the Brescia law clinic, in order to share its experience with the participants.

During the Summer School there will be common sessions, and separate sessions. The former will be run by anglo-american experts of clinical teaching. The separate sessions address four groups (in separate classrooms with internet connection and any other facilities) each group will deal with one legal case for the whole week, under the supervision of Brescia clinical staff (teachers and lawyers\*). During the summer school two Trainers of Trainers (TOT), addressees teachers only, will take place.

The sessions will be run in English and the substantial focus will be on Consumer Law.  
 The summer school addresses students and clinicians. Maximum 20 students will be admitted to the summer school and they will receive partial grants to cover their stay in Brescia. Students will receive 3 ECTS for their participation and they will be awarded a certificate of attendance. Maximum 20 Clinicians and, more in general, law professors interested in Clinical Legal Education will be admitted to the summer school, regardless of their experience.

**Cases description**

**CASE 1: Mercurius (Consumer Law 1)**

The Client agreed to buy an educational program with an Italian company specialized in delivering remote professional education. The contract was signed on September 6<sup>th</sup>, 2014, within the Company's premises. The Client's intention was to attend a course providing professional skills as medical auxiliary personnel. After receiving the materials and paying part of the agreed sum, the Client perceived that the quality of the education program did not respect her expectations; in particular, the syllabus was incomplete and not clear, the materials provided poor and elementary; in sum: she doubted that she could acquire the medical skills requested by hospitals.

Therefore, on November 10, 2014, the Client decided not to pay the remaining instalments, and to withdraw from the contract. The company claimed for payments, as well as for: the restitution of the materials delivered.

The Client asked Adiconsum (a highly representative Italian consumer association) about her rights.

**CASE 2: Igea (Consumer Law 2)**

On March 2015 in a slaughterhouse close to Brescia, the public authorities noticed that the practices run by the firm over animals bound to slaughter did not precisely comply with the expected hygiene and safety. Therefore, they asked for supplementary enquires, that in fact revealed that some animals were affected by salmonella typhi.

A criminal proceeding was filed against the slaughterhouse. Adiconsum (a highly representative Italian consumer association) asked Brescia legal clinics about the opportunity of applying to join proceedings as a civil party.

**CASE 3: Efesto (Disability)**

Since 2012 Joe has been working for the sales division of *Engineering Machine Group*. His boss is Tonya, the head manager of the sales division.


