Legal clinics in a Digital Environment





http://www.lawstars.eu/ is a showcase of the work of the Consortium and offers open access to EU consumer rights and consumer rights legal clinic resources. • It addresses either to clinicians and to the target groups of the project; it is regularly updated with <u>news of events</u>, <u>articles</u>, and any interesting information regarding the <u>project</u> <u>activities</u> of the Consortium clinics (<u>educational</u> <u>materials and syllabi</u>, <u>teaching method and third</u> <u>mission</u>).  In particular, the website hosts a <u>database</u> which collects, classifies and analyzes the cases dealt with by each Partner University. All cases are reported anonymously, while the database is public. www.lawstars.eu also hosts the relevant documentation related to the three Summer/Winter Schools (run in English and focused on consumer law) organized during the lifetime of the project. These Summer/Winter Schools allowed the students to meet with other students and to learn from experts of other clinics from different countries. It also allowed academics and stakeholders to benefit from the experience of participating to a structured replica of the traditional clinical activities of the host University, holding special clinical sessions and reproducing the local methods and the pedagogical approaches applied.

www.lawstars.eu also hosts the first proposal of the quality standards on European clinical education. Quality measures for legal clinics (not yet existing at the European level) consists of criteria formalizing the teaching methods and creating performance indicators in the field of legal clinical teaching. www.lawstars.eu also contains a selected legal clinics bibliography of the last decade.
